It has motivated young boys and girls to take up informal education centre for the children lacking studies during school shut down. This effort has created a new hope in the community.

The organization throughout the year establishes online linkages with like minded NGOs, Civil Society, and Government Officials for learning and dissemination of activities. Time to time it has also arranged capacity building program for its management and staff to move forward in midst of this challenge.

We would offer our heartfelt gratitude to Government of India, State Government of Jharkhand, Donors, Stakeholders and well wishers for supporting us in establishing firm connection with our PEOPLE.

COVID-19 Response

Distribution of Dry Ration

In the wake of the novel coronavirus pandemic, Caritas India has distributed dry ration to the underprivileged. The partner dioceses have been providing free food to the needy at the time of the global crisis. Community kitchens have been made nodal points for the distribution of free food to the poor and underprivileged. The distribution has been done in the villages and social distancing and hygiene norms are being adhered to while delivering the food to needy persons.

The organization has reached out to 450 families' marginalized communities and 273 families from Paharia Communities.

Community members were trained to reinforce the message of good health, hygiene practices and social distancing through community sessions, and public gathering.

Most marginalised communities especially migrants and daily wage earners received humanitarian support like masks and sanitizers following the Government directives.

Project Objectives

Objective 1: 60% Marginalized families have increased their income by 20% through small and marginal farmers' organization, various adaptive initiatives (on-farm, off-farm & forest) and linkages.

Objective 2: By the end of year women participates actively in governance by demanding their rights, entitlements and perform their social and constitutional duties with responsibility.

Objective 3: Improved maternal and child health care by strengthening of Health system for Routine Immunization.

Objective 4 – Enhanced ability of adolescents, both girls and boys, to make decisions about matters, be it psychological, familial, social, or economical, that affect their lives.

OVERALL OUTCOMES

- 347 farmers adopted second crop.
- 179 farmers are using compost manure.
- 113 farmers are preparing organic pest repellent and using it.
- 87 women and adolescent girls raised nutrition garden
- 124 families have planted 280 fruit saplings
- 176 men and women are aware of PESA Act
- 81 families got benefits of PM Awas
- 2 Physically challenged got pension
- 63 men and women submitted work demand under MNREGA
- 12 men register for job card.

- 37 families received ujjwala Yojna benefits
- 10 families got their ration card.
- 53 Village Health Nutrition Day provided services
- 33 left out children immunized
- 25 pregnant women registered in Anganwadi Centre
- 2 Malnutrition children sent to MTC.
- 40 adolescent girls continued their study after passing out class 9th.

Initially she was not regular in the meeting but slowly other members encouraged her to come regularly and involve her in group activity, she become active. Regular study activity on effects of early marriage, scope for girls in the sector and education and sports motivated her to go for sports. Today Rina is playing as a Stricker from Team, Salpatra. On 10th of December, she participated in girls football tournament organized at Jobjitpur. Though the team not got success but the entire management for playing the tournament was amazing.

Now Renna is serious about her carrier and motivating girls to pursue higher education. She dropped her decision of early marriage. She realized that good friends always help in creating a good environment and building a positive life.

Project Objectives

Advancing girls' leadership by working directly with girls Activities

Outcomes

- 11 adolescent girls protected from being getting married at an early age.
- The training and continuous dialogue with parents and family members by the project team made parents realized the implications of early marriage.

Mobilizing families, communities, and influencers

- 37 active peer educators' leaders are active in organizing the value creating group meeting.
- In village like Sharghati, Jitko, Ambajora, Kamardiha, the peer educators have generated awareness of COVID-19 during lockdown period with precautions measures.
- The active peer educators are continuously encouraging their drop out friends to enroll themselves.
- The project team and peer educators successfully motivated 15 drop out girls for enrolled in formal school
- Koyal Kishori group of Kamradiha village generated awareness on COVID-19 among family and community
- Twa Baha Kishori Group from Chilgojori done home visit and had dialogue with parents on importance of girl child education.
- Avean Kishori Group from Jabjitpur through street play generated awareness on consequences of engaging child for labour works force.
- Chameli Kishori Group of Ambajora and Kamal Kishori Group of Kalajor are actively motivating community for protecting boys and girls from human trafficking

Providing direct services to at-risk, married, and formerly married girls

5 Adolescents girls who got married at an early age started income generating activities like Silbanti Murmu and Nirmala Hansda from Jabjitpur village, Sushila Kishku (Kalajor village) started small snacks shop, Dhani Marandi of Jitko village started selling vegetable and Rejina Hembri of Sijhwa village selling leaf plate.

Restarted Study - Dhani Marandi (age 15), Paderkola village

The benefit of attending adolescent group meeting as an active member was that I learnt new things. My brother always objected me from going school that hurt me badly. I discontinued my study while I was in class 10 and started helping my mother at household chores. My mother was worried about by marriage, as relatives and friends, forced her for my early marriage. I have deep gratitude for peer educator who convinced my parents and brother to allow me to study. It was a big struggle but I succeed in taking admission in class 10 again this year. Now, I am actively sharing my experience with my friends to have courage to fight for right issues and have a trust own action.

Soil and Water Conservation Measures

Global Green Grant Fund

Project Village – Nipania Village of Amrapra Block

Project Aim - Generating employment and creating soil and water conservation measures

Jojo Tola (hamlet) – Farm Bund, Pipe line water supply and Check Dam

Simripara Tola (hamlet)- Farm Bund, Gully Plug

Farm Bund – This structure reduces soil erosion and also stores water in the field, helping in retaining moisture of the soil. The farm bund was initiated in the area of Pahariya Community. The land selected in Simripara and Jojo tola left abandoned since few years. Earlier it was cultivable land but due to continuous soil erosion, farmers stopped cultivating.



In Simripara, 1194 ft farm bund constructed in the land of Rajkumar Pahariya, Jabra Pahariya and Kadra Pahariya, whereas in Jojo Tola 744 ft farm bund constructed. Sujna Pahariya and Lokna Pahariya were land owner.

Check Dam – In Jojo Tola, a check dam with dimension of (6.096m x 3.658m x 19.812m) - 442cu m, 135/cu m constructed. It was aimed to make use of cultivable land.

The target of this activity was to conserve soil and water to the mitigation of the natural disaster. It was also aimed at promoting environment friendly practices in agriculture such as organic farming and to increase awareness among villagers of the existing issues. It enables villagers properly manage water through canals, streams and rivulets.



Pipe Line for water in dry season - Local Paharia community walk nearly 2 Km to collect water for daily chores and drinking purpose. As a source of water, Nijrijola nala was identified. It serves water for the entire year. Therefore, it was discussed and planned for making water available to the villagers through pipeline connectivity. This reduces the time and hard work of the villagers to draw water from 2 kms far away. People benefited of drinking water.



Gully Plug – To check the run off flow of water, 3 gully plugs constructed on Bara Jola Nala in Simripara Hamlet. The future stored water will be utilized for cultivation purpose. Also, after silting of mud in between gullies land will be formed.



The action on soil and water conservation started made community aware of purpose of these watershed measures. People have vowed to take care of these gully plugs, check dam, pipe line connection, 30*40 model as they do take care. People on their own also planted tree by using seed ball techniques.

During the project implementation, women have played an active role in mobilizing the community to complete the task on time.

International Women's Day

The celebration of International Women's Day by 'women SHG held on 9 March 2021 at Jitko Aam Bagan. The entire program was coordinated by SHG members. The entire program was the culmination of two month- of fierce challenges, impossible obstacles, joy and magnificent victories.

The program started with lighting of lamp. The eminent guests like Nisha Kumari Singh, Block Development Officer, Subasini Soren, Secretary, JVP, Filomina Soren, Jal Sahiya, Revati Soren, Teacher, were present.

The Block Development Officer said that women need to be more responsible in raising voice against exploitation. Subasini Soren encouraged the women to be active in sharing and not to play a role in gender discrimination. She also motivates them for tapping of social security schemes.

The SHG members shared their stories of changes which really motivated the participants. Around 400 women gathered to celebrate this event.
